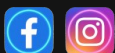


Warlords of ice, wolf kings of the Siberian wastes, Theosophy first lifted their voices in a howl of confrontation and defiance back in 2008, appearing on a split CD with countrymen Bizarrekult. This rabid and ravenous opening gambit was followed by years of fertile creativity, with the band unleashing a selection of singles, a compilation, a live album and no fewer than six full length studio albums, including the ambitious conceptual duology Eastland Tales - Part I and Part II - and the critically acclaimed Bleeding Wounds Of The First And The Last, which respected German webzine AMMO referred to as "a diverse and consistently compelling album that is essential listening for every black metal fan" in a glowing 10/10 review. Following extensive touring in support of Bleeding Wounds... in 2024, Theosophy retreated to their mountain fastness to ponder their next move. With the arrival of summer 2026 the band announced a new alliance with the Apocalyptic Witchcraft label – home of some of the most exciting extreme music acts operating today – beginning a new chapter in their storied career. And now both band and label are ready to unveil the latest breathtaking act of black metal majesty to bear the mark of Theosophy...Line Before The Event Horizon is upon us!

There is no gradual immersion into the icy waters of Line Before The Event Horizon, as opening track 'Path To The Void' erupts in instantaneous thunder, a total sensory assault. Steeped in the vital, black blooded roots of the genre this accomplished act of decimation is a shard cut from black metal's frozen heart, a staggering invocation of pure darkness through chilling riffs, tumultuous drums and a voice of venomous ichor. The jagged blades of 'Birds Under The Sky' follows, grand melodies carried forward on waves of might and an aura of omniscient omnipotence. When the blast beats hit it's like tearing through a snow-covered landscape into the maw of a biting wind; terrifying, exhilarating black metal perfection. 'Shadows Of The Earth' sends us hurtling into orbit with the words of astronaut Scott Carpenter and entwines a glorious display of speed and force with a lyrical yearning for the silent oblivion of death and decay, before Theosophy take us billions of miles from the light and warmth of the sun, to 'Neptune's Aphelion' where shocking velocities that reflect the planet's supersonic winds merge with Iron Maiden inspired guitar lines and incredible atmosphere. Then, from the farthest reaches of the galaxy, we return to Earth, to the slopes of one of Russia's highest peaks, for 'The Glow Of Uch-Sumer' where a beautiful acoustic intro transcends into imperious, blackened regality. With its sky-scraping melodies and essence of natural splendour, the cold mountain air between each note so real you can taste it, 'The Glow Of Uch-Sumer' is a momentous creation. And finally the end draws nigh, the conclusion to an album with which Theosophy have scaled previously unimagined heights...the stunning, atmospheric epic that is 'Voice From The Black'. This is desolation from the edge of existence, the black flame burning bright, timeless and endless...

Immaculately mixed by P.G. at Ad Nauseam Sounds (Foltermord, Anheim etc), meticulously mastered by Jonas Kjellgren at Black Lounge Studios (Amorphis, Immortal, Overkill etc) and adorned in grim, haunting artwork that gives visual form to the bleak imagination of the music within, Line Before The Event Horizon will be released by Apocalyptic Witchcraft on September 25th, on limited-edition vinyl, digipak CD, cassette, and digital formats. Be ready for an unequivocal reminder of the greatness that black metal can encompass.
